9- 1c cast off while\{2\} 3c dance to top giving $\mathrm{NH} \mid 1 \mathrm{c} 1 / 2$ Fig8 L (1W up, 1M down) | 1c $1 \frac{1}{4} 4$ turn LH ( 1 M now below 1W)

9- $1 \mathrm{c} \frac{1}{2}$ Reel4 with 1 cnrs (pass $P$ Lsh) ; Repeat with 2cnrs
17- Repeat with 3cnrs (1cnr person); Repeat with 4 cnrs (2cnr person)


25- $1 \mathrm{~W}+2 \mathrm{c}$ \& $1 \mathrm{M}+3 \mathrm{c}$ Reels 3 across, Lsh to 1 cnr
33$2 c+1 c+3 c$ circle 6 and back

Note: Cosh explicitly tells 1c to pass Lsh in [9-24]; however the Rsh pass is quite common, and nicknamed "Mairi's Divorce".
